Big Cat Man

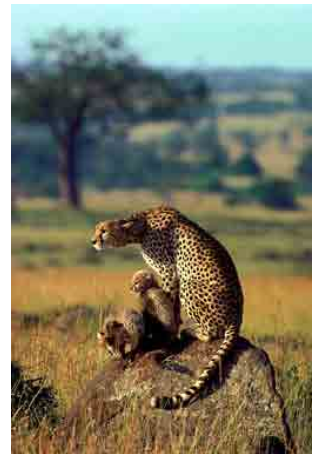

Jonathan and his wife Angie have lectured all over the world on their work as wildlife photographers and naturalists, but are perhaps best known in the UK for their television series 'Big Cat Diary' and 'Big Cat Week' that Jonathan co-presents. Most of their filming is done in the Masai Mara which is a sanctuary for more than 500 lions, and good populations of leopards and cheetahs, some of which Jonathan and Angie have followed from birth to death.



Jonathan and Angie have just finished the last in a series of three books on Africa's big cats, Big Cat Diary: Cheetah which will be published in January 2005. Jonathan's talk will focus on Cheetahs, and we are hoping to have advance copies of their new book available for sale and signature.
