Lee Farmer's talk on climbing Kilimanjaro, takes walkers from the tropics to an arctic climb in just a few days up the hardest and little known route to the summit. Lee will give an insight to life on an expedition, the experiences, the drama and the passion of climbing mountains and how climbers cope with everything from sleep deprivation, deep weariness, fear, sickness and fighting both the elements and the clock.



Lee is a professional mountaineer and expedition leader, who has climbed mountains on all the world's continents, and is a specialist in extreme environments. He has successfully climbed Mount Everest and been to the South Pole three times.



He has co-presented on BBC radio and appeared on both BBC and Independent Television, in addition to travel writing and taking people into the mountains for team building and personal development.
