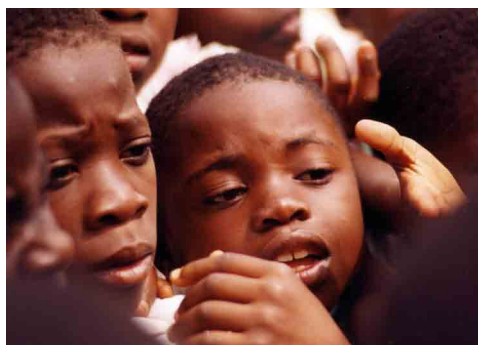
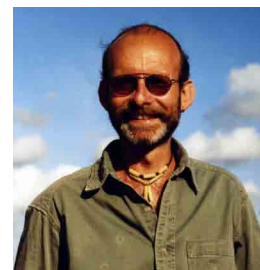


"Traveling on two wheels is the perfect way to explore a continent like this; it's all about freedom and the ability to take advantage of opportunity".
